Washer and Dryer average cost	\$2,000
Refrigerator average cost	\$1,000
Stove average cost	\$1,000
Smaller appliances will cost about	\$1,000
Fees for our U.K Visas will be	\$1,000
Shipping container will cost	\$6,000
